## Competition Regulations

The competition will be run under SOBHD Constitution & Rules and ScotDance Canada Bylaws & Competition Organizers' Manual

- Field entries will NOT be accepted. No refunds.
- AGE: Applies to the date of competition. Competitors may be requested to furnish proof of age. Competitors may enter only in events to which his/her age applies and in the correct classification (e.g. Beginner). Please refer to the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing Constitution and Rules.
- Competitors must have a valid ScotDance/SOBHD Card.** All dancers **must** present their ScotDance cards prior to dancing. No card at the competition will result in a \$5.00 penalty fee; awards (including stamping of card) will be withheld until card is presented to competition chair.
- Classes will be divided after the closing date for entries at the discretion of the Competition Chair(s). Three competitors constitute a class, however, should there be a single entry where classes cannot be combined, the competitor will be judged. All other classes will be divided according to entries received after the closing date at the discretion of the Competition Chair(s).
- All status changes must be sent or phoned immediately to the Competition Chair ([kendra@jonespilatesandhighland.com](mailto:kendra@jonespilatesandhighland.com) or (306) 821 - 6061, leave a message). **NO CHANGES** allowed on competition day.
- COMPETITORS: must be suitably attired; must be on hand to dance when their event is called or forfeit the right to dance in that event; last to enter - first to dance; must not wear or display medals until after the competition; must be in FULL COSTUME to receive medals.
- Communication with a judge concerning a competitor will result in disqualification of that competitor. Any protests must be in writing and handed to the Competition Chair prior to the end of the competition, accompanied by a protest fee of \$15.00. Decision of the Judges will be final.
- Medals and trophies will be awarded. There is no trophy for the Primary Class. The scoring system of the Scottish Official Board of Highland Dancing will be in effect; 88, 56, 38, 25, 16, 10.
- Awards are presented using the scale of half plus one (Maximum 6 awards). In the case of 8 dancers, for example, 5 awards will be given; where there are 9 dancers, 5 awards will be presented.
- All Dancers with a valid Local Highland Dancing Association Membership from **ANY province** will pay \$6/dance. All dancers without a local Membership will pay \$10/dance.
- Choreography dances cannot be longer than 4 min. Choreographies must include at least 3 dancers. As per SOBHD rules both Pre-Premier and Premier dancers are eligible to compete in choreography. Dancers can only participate in one choreography. All dancers participating in choreography must show a valid SOBHD / ScotDance card. A list of dancers names, ages as of Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> and valid SOBHD / ScotDance numbers must be provided upon entry. All dancers must should their valid ScotDance / SOBHD card on the day of the competition.
- Special Event Fling is open to all Beginner & Novice dancers. Age groups within Beginner & Novice will be determined at competition organizer's discretion. Awards TBA.
- The Premier dancer (s) acquiring the most dance points over the Oct. 22nd BHDA Battlefords Competition & the Oct. 23<sup>rd</sup> CBHDA Lloydminter Competition will be awarded the 'Midwest Dancer of the Days'. Prize TBA. Should either of the competitions be cancelled the award will be given to the Premier dancer with the most dance points at the remaining competition.
- Should there be less than 70 entries by Oct. 13<sup>th</sup>, 2011 the CBHDA reserves the right to cancel the competition. Should cancellation occur you will be notified via email.
